### Golf Course Chatter

#### Turf grass and Compaction

Some of the thin grass areas around the golf course are caused by cart traffic. Most of the thin areas have marginal growing conditions to begin with and cart tires will damage the turf.

The pull off area adjacent to hole #9 is a prime example. Here, the soil is fine and rocky with very little organic matter. This is also shady with tree roots competing for the limited moisture that is available. Grass cover is usually thin here, but it can survive if traffic and mowing is limited. Carts will be restricted to the trail on hole #9 this year to see if the turf grass will be improved from last season.

Many other areas on the course continually suffer the effects of cart traffic. Trial edges adjacent to tees and greens suffer. Limited access areas of holes 8,13,10, &18 where carts are "funneled" into certain points due to topography are compacted. Observing signs, posts, ropes, lines, and bumpers will make your course more playable.

#### Casey's Tip of the Month

If you are having trouble drawing the ball from right to left, try this simple little change in your set up. Make sure you set your head behind the ball at the address and keep it there. This requires complete concentration. If you stay behind the ball through impact, you will find that you can release the club head before the hands get ahead of the ball, which is what you must do to hit a draw. It will also help if you will close your stance a little and make sure the club is coming through on an inside to out swing path.
